Applicant qualifications:

- Minimum GPA of 2.5
- Must be graduating or already graduated from a secondary school (high school or home school) and enrolled at least part-time in a postsecondary, vocational or technical school.

- Impact Ministry (provides food and clothing to those in need in Christian Co)
- Hispanic Ministry (new Hispanic missions and Hispanic outreach to immigrant)
- Baptist Campus Ministry (outreach to students at Hopkinsville Community College)
- Restorative Justice (jail ministry)
- Building Repair –provide manual labor for small repair projects of individuals in need
- Toys from Heaven (collect toys during Christmas for children)
- Tiny Tots (housed within the Impact Ministry this ministry provides baby needs such as diapers, formula and clothing


