

Consider Supporting Impact Ministry during the Winter Months

Did you know that for the month of September, Impact Ministry counseled 205 families and served a total of 517 people? And they are only open 12 days of the month for 2 hours each day! That is 8-9 families being ministered to every hour through Christian counseling and receiving food for their family and meeting clothing needs as well.

Did you know that Impact Ministry has a dedicated group of volunteers that give of their time providing spiritual counseling, organizing and distributing the food for families, and sorting and organizing clothing donations.

Did you also know that Impact Ministry operates strictly on donations from CCBA churches and other churches and groups in Christian County. Impact Ministry is able to order food from Feeding America at a low cost so that the dollars given can go further.

During the winter months Impact Ministries sees a large increase in the amount of families that are served, which means they distribute more food, if it is available. **Will YOU and YOUR CHURCH consider a food drive or possibly a love offering for Impact Ministry?**
